**City Prefectural Tax** All Installment / 1st Installment

\*Deadline is June 30th Thursday. (Same date with direct debit)

\*Direct debit is convenient for tax payment. If you want to switch to direct debit, please take the necessary procedures at least one month before the deadline.

#### <Consultation counter for tax payment on JUNE (SUNDAY)>

Consultation counter is open on last Sunday of every month for those who are having a hard time coming at the city hall on weekdays and wants to consult regarding the tax payment.

\*Be sure the person themselves will visit the counter.

### Tax Payment of Vehicle Tax (Category base)

Deadline of 4th Year of Reiwa vehicle tax (category base) is May 31st (Tuesday).

If your payment get delay, you will be paying the tax with delinquent charge.

And also, if you leave the unpaid tax, we will investigate your assets (Real estate, vehicles, salaries, and savings.) and disposition may be executed.

## Assistance for getting the my number points

If you have any questions regarding the my number points, don't hesitate to visit the temporary counter at the city hall.

**Place:** Yuki City Hall 1st floor right next to the information counter.

**Time:** 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. (Excluding Saturdays Sundays, Public Holidays and Lunch time 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

**You need to bring:** My number card, Password of the card, Debit card or points card, and bankbook. (Paypay, au pay, Nanaco, Torisen Card, and others.)

## How to print out official certificates at convenience stores

If you have a plastic My Number card, and have set up the two passwords for it, you may be able to print out the certificates you need at your local convenience store.

Convenience store multipurpose machines (ie. the large printers) can be a convenient alternative to a trip to the city office if what you need is a simple certificate.

**Need to bring:**

- My number card (Plastic card with photo)
- Password for your card (4 digits)

**Available time:** 6:30 to 23:00 everyday (Includes holidays)

**Fee:** 200 yen per certificate

**Certificates you can get at convenience stores.**

- Copy of resident record (Jumin hyo)
- Seal registration certificate (Inkan shoumeisho)

\*The range of documents and certificates you can print out using the plastic My Number card differs from municipality to municipality.
