《The Evacuation Support System especially for those who needs support》

We are promoting the creation of a system whereby the elderly, disabled, and other people who need assistance in evacuating in the event of a disaster can evacuate quickly through mutual assistance in their neighborhoods.

- **Eligible applicants**: People who have difficulty evacuating by themselves in the event of a disaster (excluding facility residents) among the following (1) to (5)
- (1) Households consisting solely of elderly persons aged 65 or older
- (2)Persons certified as requiring long-term care 3 or more under the long-term care insurance system
- (3) Holders of Level 1, 2, or 3 of the Physical Disability Certificate, Class 1
- (4)Persons with Levels 1 and 2 of the Mental Disability Health and Welfare Certificate
- (5)Those who have received a Grade of (a) or A for Rehabilitation Certificate (RYOIKU TECHO)



## 2025, National Health Insurance Tax rate will be changed

There is a lack of financial resources. Decrease in the Insurance tax revenue due to the decrease of subscribers, and increase in medical costs due to the aging of the population continues in Japan. In order to resolve funding shortages and ensure stable operations of National Health Insurance, the insurance tax rate will be revised as follows.
