Have you Completed Application Procedure in Response to Systematic Revision of Child Allowance ?

Systematic revision for Child Allowance has been applied since October, 2024. (Starting from December payment.)

Municipal office has sent notification to those who must apply for administrative procedure. If you haven't completed the procedure, please make sure to apply as soon as possible.

*In some cases, application form and confirmation form cannot be delivered to you successfully.

If you find yourself concerned, please visit City Hall counter or download the application form through city website and make application.

Who needs to make application?

- Those who have not been receiving Child Allowance because their income exceeds upper limit.
- Those who are not rearing a child of junior high school-age or under, but rearing a child of high schoolage (born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2009).
- **Due date for application submission :** Monday, March 31st.

(Documents must arrive no later than the due date.)

*If the application form reach us by the due date, the benefit will be paid retroactively starting from October, 2024. But if the application form reach us after the due date, the benefit will be applied from one month later than the submission date.
