● **City Prefectural Tax** **Lump-sum payment or 1st installment**

***Deadline:** Tuesday, June 30th. (Same date with direct debit.)

If you want to switch to direct debit, please take the necessary procedures at least one month before the deadline. Direct debit can be applied from a smartphone or computer.

Renewal of Labor Insurance

《 About annual renewal 》

The terms of renewal of Labor insurance for 2026 (Worker's compensation insurance / Employment insurance) is from Mon. June 1st to Fri. July 10th.

Electronic application can be accepted from Mon. June 1st at 8:00 a.m.

《 Insurance premium rate 》 Premium rate for Labor Insurance was changed on April 1st.

《 Direct debit 》 Upon application, direct debit will continuously be available from the following year onwards.

The revision of the Road Traffic Act in April

The cyclists aged 16 and over, a system of fines is in place for minor violations.

Those are *Running red light *failing to stop at stop signs *using a smartphone while driving and *riding with an umbrella. When car drivers pass cyclists on their right side, they are required to make a safe distance (approximately 1.5m) or proceed slowly.

When driving a car or riding a bicycle, please be considerate of others and drive safely.

Necessary Procedures of National Health Insurance

Regarding National Health Insurance, enrollment process and withdrawal process are not automatically carried out. You must carry out the necessary procedures within 14 days.

- You will be paying 100% medical expense at medical institution if you are not enrolled in National Health Insurance.
- You will be charged for National Health Insurance if you don't proceed withdrawal procedure. (If you are enrolled in other type of health insurance, it means you will be charged twice.)
- If you used National Health Insurance card after you had lost the qualification, you may be asked to pay it back.

Protect farmland

When reclaiming farmland to alleviate low-lying areas, permission under the Agricultural Land Act and other relevant laws may be required. Furthermore, burying industrial waste or other materials can only lead to liability for the landowner but also cause inconvenience to neighbors, potentially resulting in significant costs for restoration and other measures.

Permission under the Agricultural Land Act and other relevant laws is also required when using farmland for purchases other than agriculture.

When reclaiming farmland or undertaking other similar activities, please consult with the Agricultural Committee or the Agricultural Committee Secretariat in advance.
