Deadline of Tax Payment (JULY)

- **Fix Asset and City Planning Tax** (*Koteishisan-zei, Toshikeikaku-zei*) 2nd installment
- **National Health Insurance** (*Kokumin Kenko Hoken-zei*) Lump-sum, 1st installment
- **Medical Insurance for the Elderly** (*Koki Koreisha Iryo Hoken-ryo*) Lump-sum, 1st installment
- **Long Term Care Insurance** (*Kaigo Hoken-ryo*) Lump-sum, 1st installment

*Deadline is Friday, July 31st. (Same date with direct debit.)

*Direct debit is convenient for tax payment. If you want to switch to direct debit, please take the necessary procedures at least one month before the deadline.

<**Sunday consultation on tax payment on JULY**>

Consultation counter is open on last Sunday of every month for those who are unable to come to the city hall on weekdays and wants to consult regarding the tax payment.

● **Date and Time:** Sunday, July 26th, 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

***Advance reservations are required.**

Exemption and Deferral of National Pension insurance Premiums

If you are having difficulty paying your insurance premiums, you can apply for and receive approval to be exempted from or deferred from paying them.

● **Application period starts :** From Wednesday, July 1st

*For fiscal year 2026 (from July 2026 to June 2027).

● **Requirements:** Pension book or Pension number notification letter • Residence card (Zairyu Card).

《Due to unemployment》

• The copy of Qualified Recipients Certificate of Employment Insurance (*Koyo Hoken Jukyū shikakusha sho*) or the copy of Unemployment Certificate (*Rishokuhyo*).

● **Notes:**

If you have previously received approval for a full exemption or deferral and requested to continue the exemption when applying, you do not need to apply again as a continuation review will be conducted.

However, those who have been approved under special circumstances or who are eligible for partial payment must apply.

«We will send a "Qualification Confirmation Letter" or "Qualification Information Notice" for those who are enrolled in **National Health Insurance**.»

• Those who have a "Mainahokensho"—a Health Insurance card linked in *My Number Card*— will receive a "Qualification Information Notice".

• Those who do not have a "Mainahokensho"— those whose Health Insurance card is not linked with *My Number Card*—will receive a "Qualification Confirmation Letter" by mail by the end of July.

~National Health Insurance tax notices will be sent out in mid-July.~

* National Health Insurance tax is levied on each household,
and **the householder is responsible for paying the tax.**

A new recipient certificate takes validity from July 1st. When you receive your new recipient certificate, please check the details and use it from July 1st. Your previous recipient certificate will expire on June 30th, so please dispose of it yourself.
